STEP #1 Apply

Apply for admission

- ___ Review the academic calendar online
- ___ Complete the online application to the college
- ___ Discover your CougarID & Username & set-up your Password at www.cscs.edu; click Quick Links, then Usernames/Passwords (wait 24-48 hours for your application to be processed)
- ___ Check your CSCC student e-mail for notification of your acceptance to the college
- ___ Send official transcripts from all colleges previously attended to:
Columbus State Community College, Records and Registration Department,
Madison Hall 201, 550 E. Spring St., P.O. Box 1609, Columbus, OH 43216-1609
- ___ Final, official high school transcripts and/or GED records must also be sent if required for your program of study, scholarships, financial aid verification, or to meet prerequisites for programs or courses
- ___ *Non-U.S. Citizens:* Submit documentation (copy of both sides of permanent resident card, I-94 Departure/Arrival card, passport stamp, or letter from the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services [USCIS] verifying immigration status) to the Admissions Office in the lower level of Madison Hall



Apply for financial aid and scholarships (apply early!)

- ___ www.fafsa.ed.gov (school code: 006867); high school seniors should apply as early as January/February if graduating in the spring
- ___ For help, attend a FAFSA workshop; call the Student Assistance Center at 614-287-5538 to make a reservation (for admitted student)
- ___ Apply for all applicable scholarships (Think Again, Partnership, Success, Future Scientists of Ohio, CSCC Foundation Scholarships)



IMPORTANT: Do not proceed to the next steps until you have received notification of your acceptance to Columbus State Community College (by student e-mail or official acceptance letter)

STEP #2 Getting Started Orientation (GSO)

- ___ All new, returning, transfer and transient students: Complete online **OR** reserve your spot for an in-person session

STEP #3 COMPASS/ESL Placement Testing

- ___ Required for ALL new students WITHOUT transfer credit for BOTH college level English and math (High school students, complete testing after graduation, unless starting Summer Quarter)
- ___ Returning, transfer and transient students with college credit for BOTH college level English and math, proceed to STEP #5

TIP: Always bring your photo ID, Username, Password, & Cougar ID number with you EVERY time you come to campus.

STEP #4 Post-COMPASS/CougarWeb Workshop

- ___ Attend a Post-COMPASS/CougarWeb Workshop; locations, times & days will be given to you following your COMPASS test

STEP #5 Register and Pay Fees

- ___ New students with transfer credit for BOTH college level English and math, call 614-287-5353 to schedule an appointment with an advisor (when meeting with advisors, always bring copies of all transcripts or other documentation of completed courses to receive assistance with course selection)
- ___ Transient students- bring official or unofficial transcripts to the Student Assistance Center in Madison Hall 225 for assistance with registration
- ___ Register for classes. Need help with the registration process? --> Attend a CougarWeb Workshop
- ___ Pay fees, including a one-time, non-refundable matriculation fee (\$50) charged to all first-time registered CSCC students, and parking permit (\$25 per quarter)
- ___ Register with Disability Services (if needed) – Eibling Hall 101, 614/287-2570 (Voice/TTY)
- ___ Buy books at the CSCC Discovery Exchange or at the CSCC Bookstore online
- ___ Locate classrooms and parking areas; click the "About CSCC" and "Campuses" links to view map
- ___ Get your Student ID card in the Public Safety Office in Delaware Hall 047 (ten days or more after your fees have been paid)
