#### TO LOCATE MEDICAL DOCTORS IN AREA:

- f Click on Patient's Corner
- f Click on Physician Finder and follow the instructions to locate a doctor in your area.

Once you locate a doctor, you can call the office and ask if they are accepting new patients. If so, make an appointment. Family Practice or Internal Medicine doctors provide routine care and referral to other specialty physicians.

There are three "levels" of medical care in the U.S.:

- f Doctors' offices are used for obtaining routine care.
- f Urgent Care Clinics are used when you need care quickly and are unable to see a doctor in his/her office.
- f Hospital Emergency Room care is used for life-threatening situations. Although you can go to an "ER" on your own, often such care is obtained by calling "911" to report a problem and obtain emergency transportation to the hospital.

Urgent Care and Emergency Rooms are very expensive ways to obtain care, so it is wise to avoid them, if possible.
